

FAQs for All Courses Provided by The Safety Savvy Ltd:

Level 3 Paediatric First Aid Course

Q1: What is the Level 3 Paediatric First Aid Course designed for?

A1: This course is designed for individuals who care for infants and children, whether in a professional setting like nurseries and schools or at home.

Q2: Does this qualification meet any specific requirements?



Q2: What key topics are covered?

Q3: How long is the course and how is it structured?

A4: Successful candidates receive a Level 3 Award (England/N. Ireland/Wales) or Level 6 Award (Scotland), valid for 3 years.

Q5: Are there age or group size limits?

A5: The minimum age to attend is 14, with a maximum of 12 learners per course. Responsibility in the workplace is for those aged 16+.

Q6: How is the course assessed?

A6: Assessment includes ongoing summative practical assessments by the instructor and a written assessment for Unit 2. No external assessors are required.

Q4: What are the course highlights or content covered?

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A4: Course highlights include legal responsibilities & reporting, managing unresponsive casualties & CPR, treating fractures, burns, bleeding & choking, handling medical emergencies (heart attack, stroke, diabetes, asthma, epilepsy, poisoning, anaphylaxis), and practical bandaging & splinting techniques.

Q3: What is the duration and structure of the course?
